### **ABSTRACT**

The study was conducted to enhance the RSM comprehensive counseling program as basis to determine the students' academic performance and behavioral concerns in the classroom. The subjects of the study were the Third Year Students of the three (3) selected schools under the administration of the Religious Sisters of Mercy (RSM) in the School Year 2014-2015. The study utilized the research designs namely the descriptive method to investigate the magnitude and significance of variable relationships.

Results showed that Guidance and counseling services played an important role in the operation of the school. Such services are necessary in the holistic development of the students. Counseling services, specifically, becomes more necessary when students encounter difficulties – either behavioral or academic or both. It is presumed that the academic performance of the students, which is one of the most important aspects that is given emphasis in schools, is affected by the students' behaviours and attitudes. Thus, poor academic performance may be addressed by improving students' attitudes and behaviours. This research was undertaken with the end in view of documenting the behavioural problem that students display, analyze the reasons for the behaviours, and develop systematic intervention programs to reduce the inappropriate behaviours, which manifest in their behaviour in class and preference for certain activities and how these could determine their academic performance.
